Nominations require a description of the candidate's background and achievements, a summary of results of the work, as well as publications and other supporting documents of major importance demonstrating the candidate's contribution to the objectives of the Prize. Nominations may include relevant supporting material such as videos, publications or CD-RAMs, among others. The nomination form may be downloaded from UNESCO's girls' and women's education website <https://en.unesco.org/themes/women-and-girls-education/prize>.

5. It is, therefore, requested to kindly furnish nomination of suitable candidates as per criteria latest by **15th April, 2017** for further processing the case.
